





## Privacy disclaimer - section 13 Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 and section 13 General Data Protection Regulation 679/2016

## Data subjects: Customer

S.R.L. is Data Controller of your personal data, pursuant to and for the purposes of Legislative Decree 30 June 2003 n. 196 (Italian Personal Data Protection Code), with the present informs you that the legislation provides for the protection of persons and other subjects regarding the processing of personal data and that this treatment will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights.

Your personal data will be processed in accordance with the legislation and the obligations of confidentiality.

Purposes of processing: in particular, your data will be processed for purposes related to the implementation of the following obligations, relating to legislative or contractual obligations:

- Fiscal and accounting obbligations laws;
- Supplier management;
- Litigation management;
- Credit recovery activities;
- Customer care;
- Measurement of customer satisfaction;
- Quality management;
- Supllier history.

The data processing is necessary for thr management of the relationship and their conferment is required to implement the purposes indicated above. The Data Controller also announces that any not communication, or incorrect communication, of one of the mandatory information, may cause the inability of the Data Controller guarantee the adequacy of the treatment itself.

Modalities of the processing. Your personal data will be processed in the following ways:

- Automated processing by personal computer and software;
- Manual processing with paper archives;
- Processing operations by third parties.

Specific security measures are implemented to prevent the data from being lost, used unlawfully and/or inappropriately, and accessed without authorisation.

Data comunication: your data will be processed by Persons in Charge of the Processing expressly appointed pursuant to section 30 of Legislative Decree. 196/03.

Your data may be disclosed to third parties, in particular to:

- Advisors and freelancers also in an associated form;
- Bank and credit institutions;
- Debt collection companies;

You have the right to obtain from data controller and data processor the cancellation, the communication, the updating, the rectification, the integration of your personal data, as well as in general you can exercise all the rights provided for by article 7 of the Privacy Code provided in a copy below.

At any time you could exercise the rights listed in Article. 7 of the Act (Right to access personal data and other rights) set out below:

 A data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
A data subject shall have the right to be informed

a) of the source of the personal data;

- b) of the purposes and methods of the processing;
- c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;

d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2); and

e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.

- 3. A data subject shall have the following rights:
  - a) to obtain updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;

b) to obtain erasure, anonymization or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;

c) to obtain certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.

4. A data subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part,

a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;

b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.
